

Basketball Tournament to Benefit Talbot Hospice and the Neighborhood Service Center

Two undefeated Warrior teams from Easton High School will take to the basketball courts on August 2, 2008 to battle for the perfect record.

Led by Lamont Wilson, Class of 1992, the unbeatable teams from 1998 and 1990 will challenge one another for the ultimate title, the ultimate record of 21-0. It will be a showdown between the old school (1994-prior) and the new school (1995-2008) as the best players from both eras will battle for bragging rights. Lamont will compete on the “old grad” team having played basketball at EHS from 1989 through 1992.

A graduate of Easton High School, Lamont Wilson and other Warrior alumni have organized the event in memory of his grandmother Gloria Wilson, who was a private

sitter for Hospice patients. Money raised from this event will benefit two local organizations; The Talbot Hospice Foundation and the Neighborhood Service Center of Easton.

“Her life opened my eyes to the importance of helping others and comforting one another,” said Lamont. “She is the reason that I am doing this event; she died two years ago and I wanted to do something in her memory that would benefit the community.”

Doors will open at the Easton High School Gymnasium at 2 p.m, with the kick-off at 3 p.m. Food and beverages will be available and fans are encouraged to wear white t-shirts if they are supporting the new school, black shirts to support the old school and orange if they can't decide!

Admission is priced by age, \$7 for those 18-59, \$3 for all others and \$1 for those age 4 and under. There will be an extra charge of \$2 if you attend not wearing a team colored t-shirt! Please plan on arriving early to the Easton High School Gymnasium to witness this exciting basketball showdown, as it is expected to be a full house.
